Awards will be given for grades 5-8, and 9-12. Please do not send the work of an entire class. Nominate only the most outstanding work. Do not submit teacher assigned research papers or essays.

ART PROJECTS

Categories for the Art Projects are:

- Visual Art
- Performance Art
- Multimedia (ie. Power Point)

Criteria for the Art Projects are:

- a) Historical accuracy
- b) Originality
- c) Clear communication of meaning and message
- d) Command of spelling and mechanics (if applicable)

Requirements for presentation of materials:

- ✓ Nominating form must be completed

WRITING PROJECTS

Categories for the Writing Projects are:

- Personal Reflection
- Short story or drama (4 page limit)
- Poetry

Criteria for Writing Projects are:

- a) Historical accuracy
- b) Originality
- c) Well-developed and organized
- d) Effective use of language
- e) Evidence of voice
- f) Command of mechanics

Requirements for presentation of materials:

- ✓ Nominating form must be completed
- ✓ Double-spaced, typed or computer generated
